smolt	A fish that has not yet reached the juvenile stage. A stage of a salmon's life cycle in which it undergoes body changes so it can survive in salt water.

spillway	The part of a dam where water from the upstream reservoir "spills" into the tailrace.
tailrace	The downstream portion of a dam.
