

## Make a Paper Quadrant—Instructions

1. Cut out the quadrant below on the dashed line.
2. Glue the quadrant onto something stiff (file folder, heavy construction paper, or two pieces of craft paper glued together), and cut to the shape of the outer perimeter of the quadrant.
3. Fold the edge labeled “Fold Here” on the dashed line and tape it onto your straw or ruler, several centimeters back from the end.



4. Punch a hole using a hole-punch or the tip of a pencil and thread a 6 inch (15 cm.) long string through the hole.
5. Tie a knot at the end of the string that is on the blank side of the quadrant (the end that you threaded through the hole). Tie a weight to the other end of the string so that it hangs in front of the printed side of the quadrant, along the lines and numbers.
