Suppose we **triple** the size of a figure.

1. The general shape of the figure will be C the original figure.
2. The lengths of any line segments in the figure will be C the segments in the original figure.
3. The perimeter of the image will be C the original figure.
4. The area of the image will be D the original figure.
5. The angles of the image will be B the original figure.
