

Sample Graph Answer Key

1. Complete the following table with the data gathered from the test strips.



- 2. What patterns do you see in the graph? What conclusions can you draw?
- A) Higher concentrations contain more glucose: The 20% glucose solution has a higher glucose level than the 10% glucose solution, showing that more concentrated solutions contain more glucose.
- B) The artificial sweetener solution has 0 glucose units, meaning that not everything that tastes sweet raises glucose levels.
- C) Soda and sports drinks, despite tasting different, have the same glucose level.
- D) Even though both sugar and glucose solutions are sweet, sugar solutions show lower glucose levels than glucose solutions at the same concentration.
